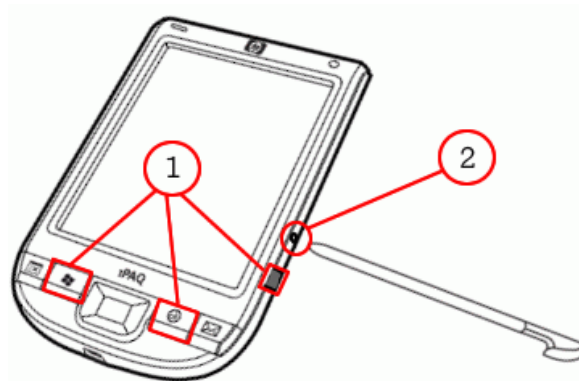


How to do a hard reset on a HP iPAQ 110/210

A Hard Reset, also known as a Factory Reset is a process which will wipe the information on your iPAQ out and restores it to a state of original purchase.

All of the information and newly installed programs will be lost after a hard reset.



1. Turn the iPAQ on.
2. Press and hold the Windows, OK, and Recording buttons (labeled 1 in the diagram above).
Note: On the iPAQ 210 the recording button is located on the left side.
3. While continuing to hold the 3 buttons press and release the small circular reset button with your stylus (2 in the diagram above).
4. Once you release the reset button(2) your machine will reset and the HP iPAQ screen that follows should read **CLEAN BOOT** in green text on the lower right-hand side of the screen.
5. If you do not see **CLEAN BOOT**, repeat steps 2-4.
